Who is America SCORES?

America SCORES inspires youth to lead healthy lives, be engaged students, and have the confidence and character to make a difference in the world. SCORES' core programming centers around an innovative, team-based, school-based model that integrates poetry/spoken word, soccer, and service-learning into a cohesive whole-child program, which we deliver through free after school programs and summer camps. America SCORES serves more than 15,000 high-need students at Title I public schools every year across North America.

What is the SCORES Cup?

America SCORES is proud to host the world's largest annual corporate charity soccer tournament series, the SCORES Cup, which has run for the past 15+ years across our 16 cities in North America. With over 350 corporations having previously participated, and run in partnership with many Major League Soccer (MLS) and National Women's Soccer League (NWSL) teams, our premier corporate soccer tournaments raise on average \$1.5-\$2 million for SCORES programming each year, one of the drivers for us being able to run free soccer and literacy programming for so many youth every year.

Tournament Location:

The 2024 Philadelphia SCORES Cup will be held at WSFS Bank Sportsplex, 2501 Seaport Dr, Chester, PA 19013 (near Subaru Park). We will be on Fields 5 and 6.

Tournament Schedule:

Check-in will begin at 7:45am on Saturday, Aug 17th, 2024 and remain open until kickoff. All players must check-in in order to receive their jersey. In order to check-in, players must have already filled out the online waiver, or fill in a paper waiver during check-in. Online waiver check-in will end on Friday night in order to prepare the physical rosters.



Group stage matches will kick-off at 9:00am and run until noon. Each team will have a lunch break from noon – 12:30pm. After lunch, the playoff rounds will kickoff at 12.30pm, with the SCORES Cup and Challenge Cup Finals kicking off around 1.30pm. **All companies will make the playoffs.**

Player waivers can be submitted here: <https://waiver.fr/p-edSYu>. Note that online waivers will close on the night of Friday, Aug 16th, to allow for time to create the physical rosters.

Parking:

Sufficient parking is available at WSFS Bank Sportsplex and is free.

Check – In:

All players will be required to check-in prior to their first game (no later than 10:00am) on Saturday, Aug 17th. During checkin, players will receive their jerseys, a gift bag and complete a player waiver if they have not done so ahead prior to arrival. **Players will not be allowed to participate without completing a waiver.**

Team/Roster Requirements:

- Games will be 7v7 (6 field players and 1 goalie).
- **A minimum of two (2) female players** from each team must be on the field at all times.
- The maximum roster size is 15.
- A minimum of five (5) players must be present at the start all tournament games in order to prevent a forfeit.

Games:

Each participating team is guaranteed a minimum of 3 group stage and 1 playoff game. Games will be ***22 minutes*** in length; Play-off games will be held following the completion of group stages after the lunch break.

Field Surface:

All Fields are **TURF**.

Spectators / Friends, Family & Colleagues:

The Philadelphia SCORES Cup is an open event and any friends, family or colleagues are more than welcome to join as spectators! We can only guarantee there will be enough breakfast and lunch for the participating players, but once players have been served, all guests are welcome to be included.



Volunteers

All referees are professionals supporting America SCORES. Please treat them with respect and gratitude for spending their Saturday refereeing in support of America SCORES' mission to ensure the Cup is enjoyable for all players. All tournament staff and photographers are also professionals that are volunteering their time.

Photos:

A professional photographer, volunteering their time in support of the America SCORES mission, will be taking team photos and action shots during the matches. These photos will be available in due time after the Cup, and the links will be shared with all team captains and co-captains.

Tournament Rules:

Rules are standard modified 7v7 rules, **with strictly no slide-tackling.** Playoff matches, if tied, will go directly to penalty kicks (3 per each team). Substitutions will be made "on the fly" from half-field (you do NOT need the referee's acknowledgement to make a substitution - unless it's the goalkeeper - and as long as the departing player has left the field).

Each captain has received a copy of the tournament rules, should you have any more detailed questions.

Facilities:

Restrooms will be available on the playing grounds.

First Aid:

A certified Athletic Trainer will be available throughout the tournament to take care of all medical needs.

Uniforms:

Official 2024 Philadelphia SCORES Cup jerseys will be provided; they are to be worn during all tournament games. You will only be able to receive a jersey upon completing a player waiver.

Equipment:

- **SHIN GUARDS are MANDATORY for all players**
- Only **molded rubber cleats**, sneakers, and **artificial turf soccer shoes** will be allowed.
- Anyone wearing **screw in** or **metal studs** will **NOT** be allowed to play!
- **Teams are expected to bring any necessary goalkeeper equipment.**
- Game balls will be provided; teams do not need to bring any additional balls

Food/Beverage:

America SCORES will provide water, Gatorade, lunch and snacks throughout the day. Lunch is provided for all participating players and volunteers, and if there is any extra, guests of players are welcome to join in. Please join us during the day in thanking our beverage sponsors, Pepsi!

To reduce our impact on the environment, players are asked to help deposit bottles into the appropriate recycling bins.

Weather:

The tournament will proceed, rain or shine.
